



## INFORMATION FOR PEOPLE ATTENDING NONSUCH MANSION FOR COVID-19 VACCINATION APPOINTMENTS

Nonsuch Park, Ewell Road,

(Cheam Gate entrance)

entrance at the front of the  
building and exit at the rear.

### IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- **Please DO NOT attend the vaccination centre unless you have an appointment.**
- If you have COVID-19 symptoms (e.g., new, and persistent cough, high temperature, loss of smell and taste) please re-arrange your appointment by contacting your GP practice.
- You are required to wear a face covering (mask or visor) and you should bring this you. If you are unable to wear a mask, please bring a visor. There will be a strict *“no face covering, no entry / no vaccination”* policy.
- You must use hand sanitiser on arrival at the Mansion.
- You must maintain social distance at the vaccination site and are asked to attend alone. If you require assistance, the person helping you will only be permitted to accompany you to the entrance of the building and should collect you from the exit. Only the person booked in for the vaccination will be allowed into the building. There will be people on site to help you.
- There will be dedicated parking for people attending for vaccination at the site (car park closest to the mansion house) and this will be clearly signposted and marshals will be on site.
- You are asked not to drive to the Mansion house itself, even to drop off, unless absolutely necessary.
- You will need to complete a pre-vaccination assessment form on arrival, and, where possible, you should do this in your vehicle (a marshal will give you the form on arrival).
- You should not arrive too early for your appointment. However, you should allow sufficient time to complete the questionnaire before entering the building for your appointment (please allow 15 minutes for this).
- Late arrivals are unlikely to be seen and there is no scope to rebook on site. You will have to do this via your GP practice.
- Toilet facilities are available outside the Mansion house itself next to the café. There are no toilet facilities inside the building.
- We expect the process to take no more than 30 mins per person. You will have to wait for 15 minutes on site after your vaccination.
- Please wear short sleeves or loose sleeved clothing under your outdoor coat.

- If you need to cancel, or rebook, your vaccination please give us as much notice as possible. Please contact your practice to cancel or re-schedule your appointment.
- If you are unable to attend, we would like to offer your appointment to someone else. The vaccine has a short shelf life and we need to use it within a specified time frame.

## DIRECTIONS TO NONSUCH MANSION

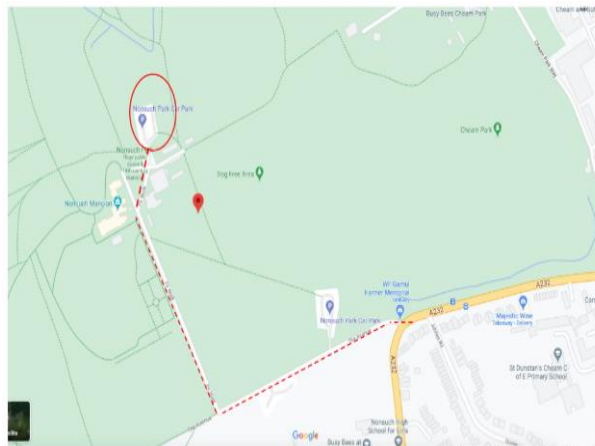
### By Road

Coming out of London on the A3

- Take a left turn at Tolworth Tower onto the A240
- Follow this for approximately three miles then take a left at the traffic lights onto the A232 towards Cheam (please ignore the current signs to Nonsuch Park along the A240)
- Follow the Ewell Road, staying left of the large octagonal church, to just past the David Lloyd gym and Bell Inn where the road bends sharply right
- Take the tight left hand turn on this bend just before the war memorial

- This brings you into the park via the Cheam Gate entrance. (This entrance is on sharp bend near Majestic Wine).
- Drive all the way down the tree lined driveway which will fork right, continue driving until you see the walled archway signposted 'Nonsuch Mansion Garden Entrance' on your left, park your car in the Guest car park on the right-hand side

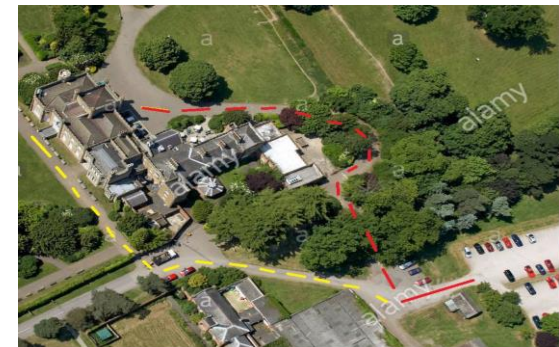

### Walking from the car park (Map 2)

- Make your way to the garden entrance walking through the archway.

- Walk down the pathway until you reach the north porch (the red markings on the map)
- The yellow markings on the map are the exit route via the south porch
